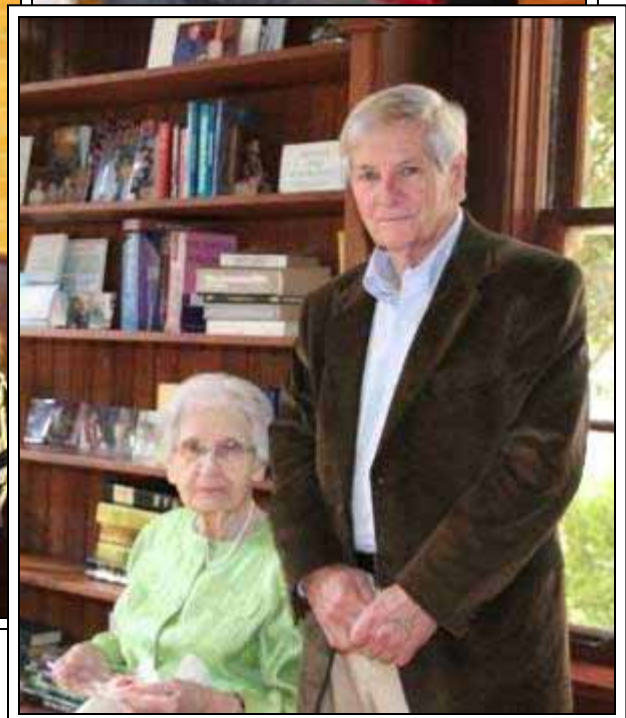

Our three communities are the One Body of Christ. The special evening of fellowship will nourish our sense of oneness.

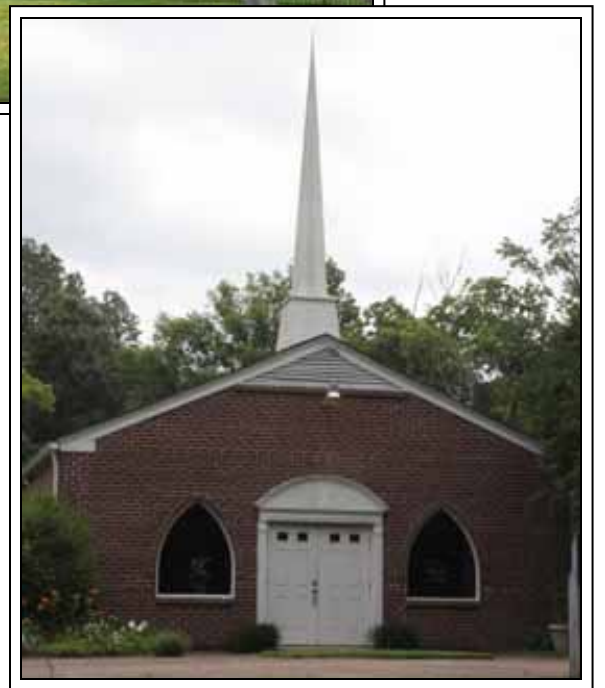

Evensong and Dinner, July 23



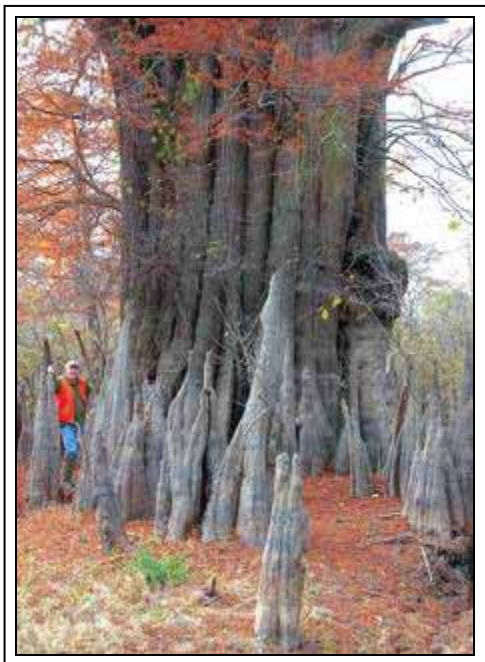
We will caravan to St. Philip's Church, 5400 Old Canton Road, Jackson, to attend Evensong, followed by dinner at Bravo! in Highland Village

The ECW met on May 9, 2015 to discuss an upcoming fun trip to Wister Gardens in Belzoni, Saturday, June 13th. We will congregate at St. Alban's at 7:30 AM to carpool to Wister Gardens, which is 78 miles from St. Alban's (1 hr, 20 min drive), take a walking tour of the gardens, view Indian mounds as we travel to Sky Lake Wildlife Management Area to walk on the boardwalk to see giant cypress trees and to view the largest and oldest (over 1,000 years old) cypress stump in the world, and then on to Indianola, Mississippi, to eat at The Crown Restaurant. There is no charge for the tours.

If there is enough interest, we will have an opportunity to visit the B.B. King Museum, which is three blocks from The Crown. There is a \$15/person charge for the museum if we go, and
