

Starting the first week of Advent and ending week four of Advent, parishioners were showered with cards. One hundred and sixty-five cards were mailed to fifteen recipients.


I am speechless (a first), by your eagerness to participate in this card ministry. I offer many thanks to my St. Alban's family for your participation.


