






ECW Field Trip to Fall Garden & Flower Festival

All the Company of Heaven

We are approaching All Saint's Day, one of my most cherished feastdays. We are all familiar with the saints who have been memorialized—who have been canonized and are honored on the church calendar. The lives of well know saints such as Saint Mary, the Mother of Jesus, Saint Francis of Assisi, Saint Augustine, Saint Teresa of Avila and Saint Julian of Norwich, are celebrated throughout the year.

What is special about All Saints' Day? This is the day when we honor all the saints in heaven. GRATITUDE & GENEROSITY

In keeping with stewardship, our community is contributing large amounts of food to the Food Backpack Ministry designed to help *children in need*. The food is distributed at Dana Road Elementary and Vicksburg Intermediate Schools to help prevent child hunger during weekends and holidays.

In addition to the Backpack Ministry, St. Alban's community donates t-shirts, underwear, socks, gloves, razors and razor blades to the men at the River City Rescue Mission. As we love and care for others we are challenged to think "outside the box" and try new ideas. This message is expressed in Romans 12:1-2: *Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.*
